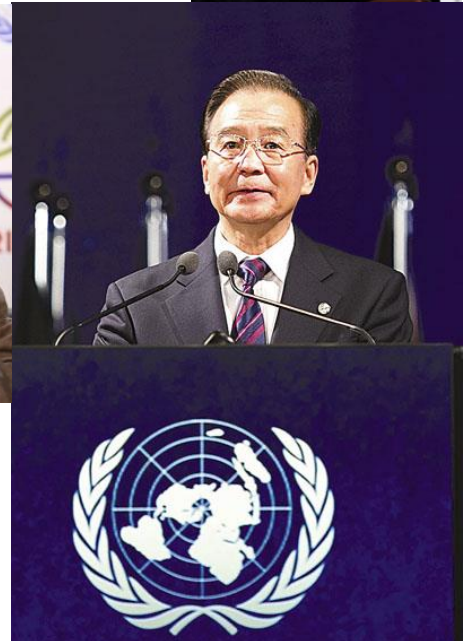




Former Chinese President **HU Jintao** indicated that Eco Forum Global should be developed into a professional high-level summit.

# OUR ORIGIN

**July 2014**

The **6th EFG Annual Summer Summit** themed around reforms was successfully convened, where institutional design and path direction of green development were intensely discussed.



**July 2013**

The **5th EFG Annual Summer Summit** themed "Building Eco-Civilization: Green Transformation and Transition – Green Industry, Green Urbanization and Green Consumption Lead Sustainable Development" was successfully held, attracting over 4,000 people including domestic and international state leaders, entrepreneurs, scholars, and media representatives.



**November 2012**

The Eighteenth National Congress of the CPC was held to propose the "Five-in-One" Scheme which raised eco-civilization construction to the national strategic level.



**2009**

The first EFG Annual Summer Summit was successfully held. It first proposed "green economy" in China.



**December 1997**

The **Kyoto Protocol** was adopted in the UNFCCC COP3, which outlined the greenhouse gas emissions reduction obligation for Annex I countries.



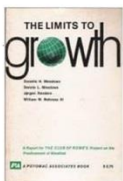
**1988**

Guizhou Provincial leaders made efforts to explore a development way leading to the harmony between human and nature, as well as social and economic sustainability, becoming the first to propose eco-construction.



**1972**

**The Limits to Growth** is a book modeling the consequences of a rapidly growing world population and finite resource supplies, commissioned by the Club of Rome.



**1962**

**Silent Spring** written by Rachel Carson was published and has become widely credited with helping launch the first environmental movement in human history.



**October 2014**

The forum "Green Finance Facilitating Smart New-Type Urbanization" was organized and convened by EFG in Hangzhou.



**November 2013**

The Third Plenary Session of the Eighteenth CPC Central Committee announced to intensify reforms of eco-civilization system and accelerate eco-civilization construction; the National Deepening Reform Leadership Team set up its first specialist group - Economic and Eco-Civilization Institutional Reform Specialist Group, indicating the inseparable relationship between eco-civilization construction and economic development as well as the great opportunity for green transformation.



**June 2012**

On the occasion of the UNFCCC-Rio+20 Summit, EFG successfully convened two side events at the Rio+20 Conference Center in Brazil, becoming the only Chinese organization of its kind that submitted a **voluntary commitment** to the Summit.

Chinese Communist Party's Seventeenth National People's Congress first officially proposed the construction of **ecological civilization**.



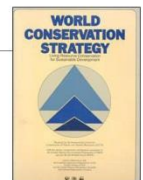
**1992**

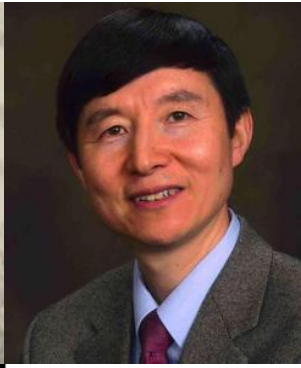
